

# KODAK CG 110-12 KODACOLOR GOLD 200



## Information

Negative film for color prints, general use. Made in France by Kodak-Paté.  
This film provides images of 0.51x0.67in. After the success of the Instamatic loaders (mod.126), in 1972 Kodak introduced Pocket Instamatic loaders (mod.110) which made it easier for the user to load and unload the film and to drastically reduce the dimensions of the cameras so as to allow them to be transported in the jacket pocket! Kodak introduced 'Pocket Instamatic 110' film as Kodachrome-X, Ektachrome-X, Verichrome Pan and kept in production until the 1990s.  
The Kodacolor Gold version is the latest product.
