

MINOLTA CASE for XG Series (1977)

Characteristics and Functions

This case is made of black leather with a red velvet interior. The front part is detachable by means of the special pin that slides into an asymmetrical slot positioned on the back. The camera is hooked up by passing the shoulder strap rings through the two leather laces with snaps on the sides of the bag bottom. The "minolta" logo in golden metal is placed in the center of the front, while the words "JAPAN" and the symbol of leather goods production are hot-engraved on the caseback.

Weight 115g. Width 155mm. Height 100mm. Depth 120mm.

N.B. Unfortunately, for the production of leather bags and cases, Minolta, in the seventies, used a combination of materials that, after years, proved to be inadequate, causing the leather part to detach from the bottom, cracking all the way to flaking, obtaining a bad result. aesthetic.
