Characteristics and Functions

The filters of the AC series - Achromatic Coating - are filters that have an anti-reflective surface treatment like the lenses, for better performance. The Minolta 1 B AC Filter is also known as Skylight. The skylight filter is suitable for general use with both black / white and color films. In color photography this filter eliminates blue in sharp shadows with clear skies; making the shadow areas blacker - and not bluish - and slightly warming the colors, removing, albeit minimally, the haze effect in landscape photographs. It does not require compensation in the exposure. It can be used permanently as a protection for the first objective lens. Black frame with "MINOLTA" logo in block capitals, this filter produced after 1981, is boxed in white cardboard boxes with golden thread bearing the new Minolta logo with the rising sun in the "O". In 1985 the graphics of the packaging were changed, taking on a thick golden border; a few years later the packaging loses its gold color and the edge becomes gray.
